This rate card has been produced for our members in the Construction industry and outlines the terms & conditions of employment for Craft Workers, Operatives and Apprentices provided for by the Sectoral Employment Order and the National Collective Agreement for the Construction Industry.

In order to grow stronger we need to make sure all construction sites are unionised and our members work with the Union to protect and improve your terms & conditions.

Make sure you work alongside Union Workers and that includes your apprentices by encouraging your colleagues to join CONNECT TRADE UNION today.

MINIMUM RATES OF PAY PRESCRIBED BY THE SECTORAL EMPLOYMENT ORDER FOR THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY

Craft Workers

The following trades Bricklayers/Stone Layers; Carpenters and Joiners; Floor Layers; Glaziers; Painters; Plasterers; Stone Cutters; Wood Machinists; Slaters and Tilers; together with a pro rata rate of pay applicable to apprentices.

Craft Worker €18.93 per hour

(Technical Operative) Cat 2/Grade A

Consists of the following categories of Skilled General Operatives, Scaffolders who hold an Advanced Scaffolding Card & who have four years' experience; Banks Operative, Steel Fixers; Crane Drivers & Heavy Machine Operators.

€18.36 per hour

(Skilled & Semi-Skilled Operative) Cat 1/Grade B&C

A basic minimum rate of pay to apply to all general operatives who have worked in the sector for more than 1 year. (Category A Worker)

€17.04 per hour

New Entrant General Operative

Applies to all new entrant General Operatives with less than one year's service working in the sector.

€13.77 per hour

Apprentice Rates of pay

1st Year	€6.31	(33.3% of Craft rate)
2nd Year	€9.47	(50% of Craft Rate)
3rd Year	€14.20	(75% of Craft Rate)
4th Year	€17.04	(90% of Craft Rate)

Note: Apprentices must be registered with SOLAS within 2 weeks of commencing employment.

There should be no pre-apprenticeship probation. Any probationary period should be included in the four year apprenticeship. For all more information log on to www.connectunion.ie

OTHER ENTITLEMENTS

Overtime rates are also protected by the SEO as follows;

Monday to Friday Normal Finishing time to Midnight - Time Plus a Half

Monday to Friday from Midnight to normal starting time the next day double time

Saturday first four hours from normal start - time plus a half thereafter all hours to normal starting time Monday Double Time.

Public Holidays Double Time plus an additional days leave.

Pension, Sick Pay & Death in Service Benefit Scheme

All Construction Workers above the age of 18 years to whom the SEO applies must be entered into a Pension/Sick Pay and Death in Service Benefit Scheme.

Employers that refuse to pay the appropriate rates of pay or provide the Pension/Sick Pay and Death in Service Benefit Scheme may be pursued by the UNION under the new legislation.

Annual Leave remains at 21 Days per Year and details can be found on our website.

Other entitlements such as travel time remain as before (set out in the National Collective Employment Agreement) and are protected through the Collective Strength of Trade Union workplaces.
